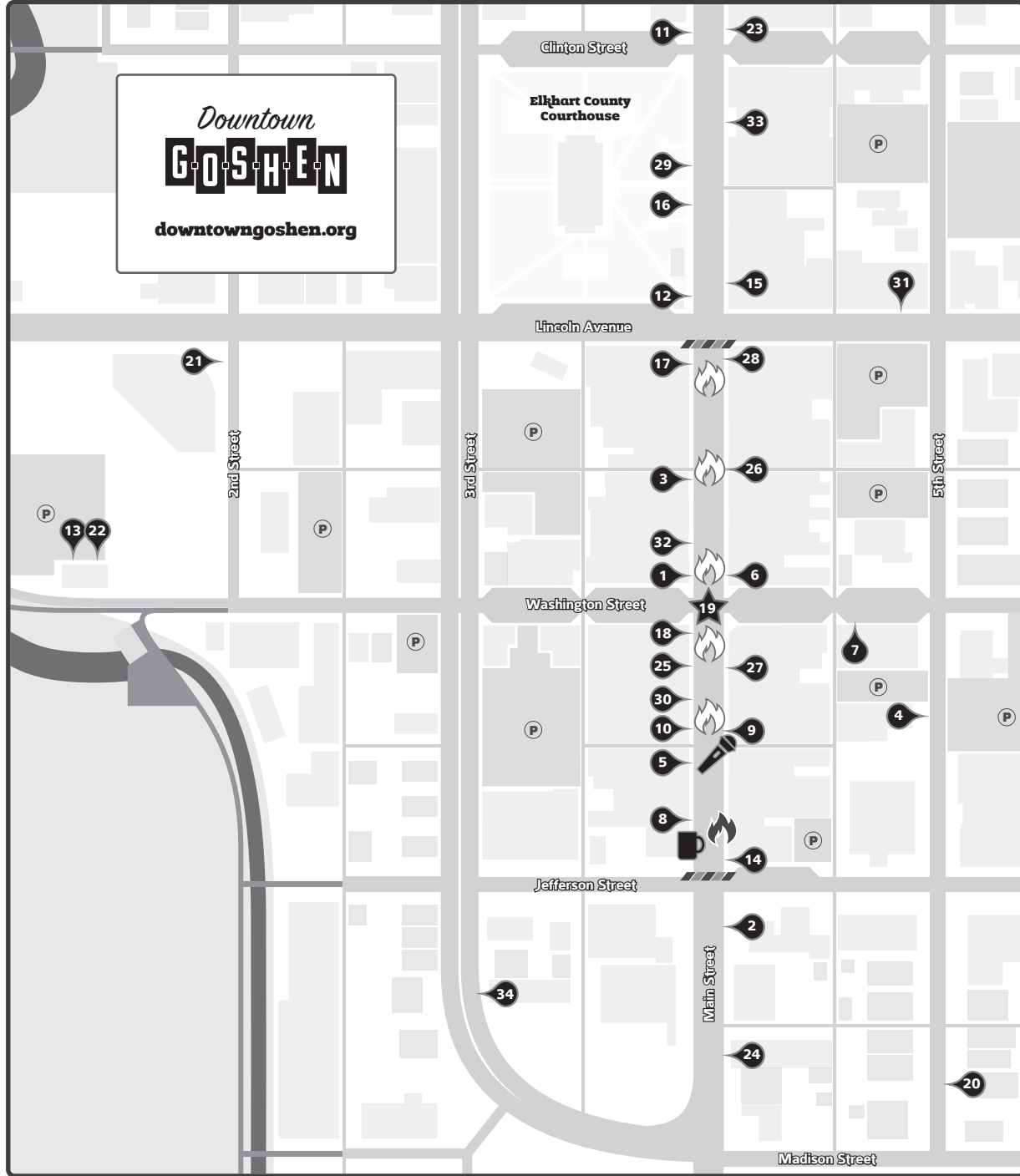

### Health and Safety

Per the Elkhart County public health order, masks are required.
